

What is the Early Years Pupil Premium?

- It is extra money from the Government to support your child's nursery education.
- Brunel Nursery could receive up to £302 a year to spend on your child to support their learning if you are eligible.

How can it help my child?

Nursery will use this extra money to support your child's learning in areas such as social and emotional development, speaking, listening, reading, writing and mathematics.

Is my child eligible?

You may apply for Early Years Pupil Premium if your child is 3 or 4 years old, is attending nursery and you receive one or more of the following benefits:

- Income support
- Job Seekers' Allowance
- Employment & Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of the State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit based on an annual gross income of no more than £16,190
- Working Tax Credit run-on
- Universal Credit

You may also apply if:

- Your child has been Looked After by the Local Authority for at least one day
- Your child has been adopted from care
- Your child has left care through special guardianship
- Your child has been subject to a child arrangement order

How can I apply?

A member of nursery staff will ask you to complete the 'Free Early Education Declaration Form' which all parents must complete to get your free nursery place. If you think you are eligible for the Early Years Pupil Premium, please make sure you complete Section D on this form.

The form will then be sent to the local authority. They will use the information to see if you are eligible and will let nursery know. Nursery will then let parents know.
