	Geography	Own locality study (human geography and land use). What is special about Blackburn. What fun things/activities are there to do here? Look at the human features of the area.
	Art and design	Look at examples of portraits of his mother made by David Hockney. Line drawing. Make 'Grandparent Gallery' - children take photographs and make drawings/paintings of their own grandparents - life drawing.
	Design and technology	Design a pop-up toy.
<b>Heroes and Heroines</b>	History	Significant global events Significant people (famous explorers from history) Events beyond living memory. Significant people (Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole) Significant local events (building of school/hospital/mosque)
	Geography	Leonardo da Vinci - study of his helicopter design and other of his works including the Mona Lisa.
	Art and design	Use of IT (Photobooth programme) to create own images in style of pop art (using Mona Lisa as starting point)
	Design and technology	Design own helicopter with moving rotors - add own design.

	Geography	Continents and oceans Maps and atlases; compass skills Seasonal weather patterns (local and non-European) Location of hot and cold areas of planet. Islands and coasts. Study of contrasting biomes (Underwater and temperate regions)
	Art and design	Study work of Caribbean artist Lloyd 'Dove' Braffith - use range of materials and techniques to create own art work in the same style - line, shape, texture.
	Design and technology	Model of the Caribbean, incorporating correct geographical details. Make own Caribbean food - Caribbean beach huts.
