Welcome to the Autumn Term!

Your child has settled into class really well! They have come to school with the right attitude and have displayed a real keenness for learning! As you already know the Kingfishers is a mixed Year 1 and 2 class. Over the year your child (depending on which Year group he/she is in) will be taught their relevant Year Group objectives.

Here is a brief overview of the areas the children will be learning over the next few weeks and months.

Maths

The topics we will be covering this term are:

- Number and Place Value
- Addition and Subtraction
- Measurement (Capacity and Volume)
- Fractions (Number and Shape)
- Position, Direction and Time
- o Shape
- Multiplication and Division
- Sorting and Sequencing

Science:

Year 1 children will be learning about Animals in the first half term and then moving on to Everyday Materials in the second half term.

Year 2 children will be learning about Animals including Humans in the first half term and then moving on to investigating the uses of Everyday Materials in the second half term.

Computing

Y1 children will be learning all about online safety and how to follow instructions when working on a computer whilst exploring Purple Mash. Y2 pupils will be learning how to code using the 2Code software on Purple Mash.

English

As well as our ongoing guided reading, grammar, spelling and handwriting lessons we have three 'mini-topics' that are linked to our Autumn term topic which is 'Toys my Grandparents played with.'

These are:

- Reading a range of stories about toys and writing our own version of the Dogger story
- ➤ Reading and writing explanations about how to play with a toy/game and how to play traditional playground games
- ➤ Reading a range of playground poems from the past and the present and writing our own.

Topic

As already mentioned our exciting topic is 'Toys my Grandparents played with.' This will involve:

- Learning about toys from the past and present day
- Studying cultural differences
- Focusing on how childhood used to be different for people in the past
- Looking at what toys people played with in the past
- Creating some toy artwork
- Designing and making our own toys e.g. cup and ball
- A visit to the Blackburn museum hopefully!
