

## Curriculum news:



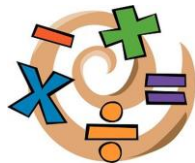
### Literacy:

### Maths:

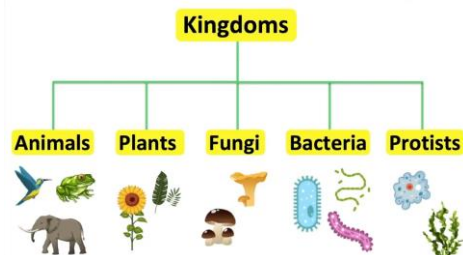

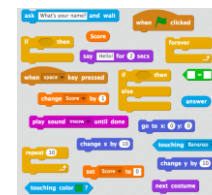

- ❖ **Spelling Test** - Thursdays. Children should learn the words given in their orange spelling homework book throughout the week. They should ideally ask you to check on their progress.
