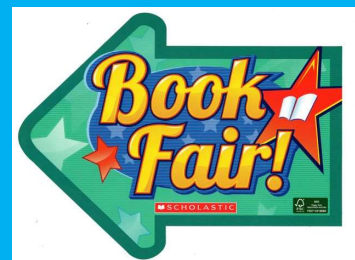
Parents' and Carers' Evening – Tuesday 10th December
