## Year 6 Bikeability Cycling Training

Year 6 children are being given the opportunity to take part in important cycling safety training. Bikeability is the government's national cycle training programme. It helps you learn practical skills and understand how to cycle on today's roads. If your child has a bike I strongly recommend that they take this opportunity to improve their cycling proficiency – it might just save their life.



The training is taking place on the 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> June. Your child will need a roadworthy bike and a helmet, although the team running the training do have a small number of spare bikes and helmets if needed. A letter was sent home about this last week – the deadline for parents to register for this training (using the QR code on the letter) is the 5<sup>th</sup> May.
