Reading & Phonics

Reading is a vital skill. Your child will bring home a reading book every night. Please read a little each night and sign the reading record.

As I mentioned last half term the children will be sitting the phonics screening this term. I will be sending home some phonics revision each week for the children to add sound buttons to the words and blend them.

Please sign the reading record book every time you have listened to your child read. For every 4 signatures, your child will receive a stamp towards a reading badge.

We give homework **every Friday** which has to be completed and returned on the following **Monday**. The homework will be closely linked to our work in class. The Homework activities can be English, Mathematics or Science based, with children sometimes being asked to find out information about a topic by doing personal research.

Spellings will be given every week and need to be practised every night. They will be tested the following week and a new set of words will then be given.

We hope you find this information newsletter useful and that it enables you to have some insight into what your child will be doing at school this term.
