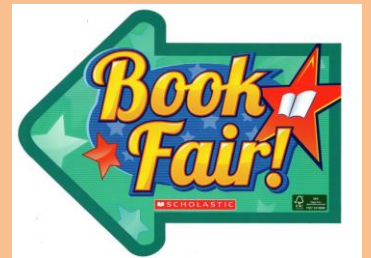
Parents' and Carers' Evening – Tuesday 9th December

Our Robins' children are looking forward to welcoming their parents and carers to their nativity assembly which will be taking place this Wednesday at 8.45am in the school hall.

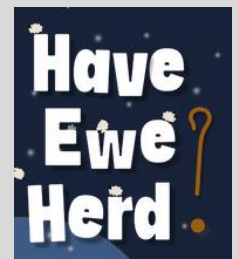
We need all of the Robins to arrive as early as possible on Thursday to get them changed into their costumes, so please get them here for as close to 8.20am as possible.
